

## Materials List for Warren Peterson's Acrylic Class

**Students can get these items at your local art supply store or order them on line from art supply stores such as Curry's, Loomis and Toles etc**

**Acrylic Paints** Liquitex or Grumbacher Academy brands, heavy body paint in tubes recommended or Winsor & Newton Galleria acrylic paints are Ok if cost is a concern.

All are 60ml tubes except for white 250 ml and must have 1 tube of each:

Titanium White, Cadmium Yellow Medium

Cadmium Red Medium, Ultramarine Blue

Cerulean Blue, Dioxazine Purple

Burnt Sienna, Hookers Green

Raw Umber, Yellow Ochre

Paynes Gray, Cobalt Blue,

Raw Sienna

### Palette

1 Canson or Reeves Tear Off Palette OR you can use large styrofoam picnic plates.

### Brushes

Generally a mix of different *long handle* brush types is needed for landscape painting since each kind offers a different style of stroke so this mix should be a good start on your way to having the right tools.

3600R Round – Sizes 2, 6, 12

3600B Bright – Sizes 2, 6, 12, 16

3600F Filbert – Sizes 6, 8

**Plus any type of good quality 2" synthetic paint brush (not foam) from Canadian Tire, Home Depot etc.**

### Canvas

1 Fredrix Canvas Pad 12" x 16", 10 sheet ( or any other make)

1 stretched canvas 12' x16"

**Students should expect to spend about \$100 on these. If you have your own brushes, canvas etc please bring them to the first class for the workshop leader to review.**

**Students should also wear a smock, apron, old shirt or old clothes *and* bring a cotton rag.**
