# EXHIBITION OVERVIEW

Realistic and recognizable sites are presented alongside semi-realistic and abstract interpretations of places to highlight the diverse ways that artists have shown the places that they see and experience. The exhibition groups these artworks into the themes of place, people and environmental issues to encourage reflection about the different ways we can see and understand places. We invite classes to explore the exhibition, and be inspired to create their own artworks!
