Summer Art Classes

The Art Gallery of Algoma is excited to offer a series of Summer Art Classes for Children!

Classes will run weekly beginning July 4th through August 18th, 2023. Morning and afternoon classes differ primarily in skill level, and age divisions are somewhat flexible based on the skill level of participants. One week of classes is \$110 for AGA Members and \$125 for the general public. Please note that classes during the weeks of July 4-7 and August 8-11 will be shortened weeks, priced at \$88 for AGA Members and \$100 for the general public.

July 4-7, 2023 - Exploring Algoma

Be inspired by the famous Group of Seven artists who explored the Algoma region. Students will use graphite, watercolors, and acrylics, and learn the art of plein air painting to create their favorite places in Algoma. Indoor and outdoor art fun!

July 10-14, 2023 - Beautiful Bugs!

Explore the world of bugs from flying insects to creepy crawlies. Students will be inspired to create painted rocks, sculptures, drawings, and paintings

July 17-21, 2023 - Celebrate Summer

Summer is here and school is out. Gardens are full and flowers are blooming, a great source of inspiration for some amazing artwork. Students will explore and create art using various techniques.

July 24-28, 2023 - ROAR!!

Join us this week to share your love of animals, big and small, short, and tall. Students will explore the animal kingdom and create their own unique animals using many different mediums.

July 31 - August 4, 2023 - Paper Creations

Students will have fun using paper in a variety of ways such as cutting, tearing, folding, and gluing. They will create realistic and abstract artwork exploring the basic elements of design.

August 8-11, 2023 - Cartoons and Animation

In this very popular class students use simple elements of animation and create storyboards to tell a story of their own. Drawing, painting, and sketching will be learned.

August 14-18, 2023 - The World of Disney

Dive into the world of Disney through a variety of art activities by being inspired by your favourite Disney stories. Be inspired to create your own fantasy or fairy-tale story with your own Disney character.

Summer Art Classes

Afternoon Classes: Ages 10+, 1:30pm-4:00pm

July 4-7, 2023 - Inspired by the Group of Seven

Students will paint in the style of the Group of Seven outside as the Group did. They will explore perspective and document the scenery around them. Current exhibitions will be used as inspiration to create art in the spirit of the Group of Seven.

July 10-14, 2023 - Eco Explorers

Explore the natural world and be inspired by flowers, pollinators, and the environment around you. Students will create artwork using recycled materials, painting, collage, and sculpting.

July 17-21, 2023 - Personal Touch

Students will paint clay pots and different vessels for everyday use. They will use different art styles from high realism to abstraction, learning about the use of colour and shapes to create different effects on objects of their choice.

July 24-28, 2023 - Flora and Fauna

Nature is a constant inspiration for artists. Art from the AGA's permanent collection will be explored to create art about birds, other animals, and nature in different mediums.

July 31 - Aug 4, 2023 - Paper Designs

Students will explore various paper crafts including collage, to create realistic and abstract artwork exploring basic elements of design.

August 8-11, 2023 - Comic Book Heroes

Students will create their own superheroes and create storyboards, comics, and artworks using drawing painting, and sketching. Bring your imagination!

August 14-18, 2023 - Modern Art

Explore the art of some famous modern artists such as Picasso, Dali, Pollock, and Warhol. Each of these artists followed their own path. Create unique pieces in a variety of mediums inspired by these artists.
