We invite students grades 1-8 to explore the exhibition online or in-person, and get inspired to create their own artwork!

Tours will be available for grades 1 to 8, in-person or online.

For classes participating in an in-person tour who would also like to do the art project in the studio, space is limited to classes of up to 30 students. For larger groups please choose the hybrid tour option.

(Begins Nov. 23) Hybrid: In-Person Tour and Activity Sheets. Art project video done back at the school classroom. (Begins Nov. 23) Students have the opportunity to submit artworks, with small writeups, to be displayed on the gallery website.
